### 3. Grounds for a Code of Conduct Appeal:

- Pursuant to F.B.A.O. Code of Conduct - AG11.4: Ground for a Code of Conduct Appeal, a final decision of the local association cannot be appealed to the Code of Conduct Appeal Panel without sufficient grounds for appeal which include:
  - Making a decision for which it did not have authority or jurisdiction as set out in the F.B.A.O. Code of Conduct
  - Failure to follow procedures as set out herein
  - Making a decision which was influenced by bias; where bias is defined as a lack of neutrality to such an extent that the decision-maker is unable to consider other views
  - Exercising its discretion for an improper purpose
  - Making a decision which was grossly unreasonable

### 4. Facts supporting this appeal:

- An attachment to this form must be included – in concise and numbered paragraphs the following information must be included:
  - 1. The grounds for the Appeal (including how the Appeal qualifies under AG11.4.1 a), b), c), d), and/or e) of the F.B.A.O. Code of Conduct;
  - 2. The supporting facts;
  - 3. Copies of all documentation available from the local association Appeal (if applicable); and
  - 4. Clearly state the desired outcome of the requested Appeal.
